As we plan for the traditional celebrations of Commencement and the Student Awards Ceremony, the following information should be helpful to you.

Student Awards Ceremony

You are invited to attend the Student Awards Ceremony on Thursday, May 24, 2018, which ***begins promptly at 6:30 p.m.*** in the Margaret L. Jackson Arts Center with a reception to follow from 8–10 p.m. in the Commonwealth College Center. This is a free event, which is open to the entire College community and their guests. Student awards are presented for academic achievement, service to the College, and other areas of performance. **PLEASE NOTE: *If selected for an award, you will receive notification from the College Awards Committee by mail prior to the event.***

Commencement

The Commencement Ceremony will be held, rain or shine, on the Elsbree Street campus under a large tent ***Saturday, June 2, 2018, at 11 a.m.*** and will be followed by a reception in the Commonwealth College Center (G building) cafeteria. Light refreshments will be served. **All ceremony participants should arrive on campus at 9:15 a.m. and check in at the Jackson Arts Center (H building) lobby.**

Additional instructions will be outlined in the *Graduation Information* memo you will receive when you pick up your cap and gown at the Bookstore. Seating for guests is provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Guests are encouraged to bring lawn chairs for seating outside of the tent.

Degrees/Certificates

You will receive a diploma cover during the commencement ceremony. Degrees and certificates will be mailed to the address you provided on your graduation application, and should be received within one month after the ceremony. If you are a December graduate, you should have already received your diploma.

Your name will ***not*** appear in the Commencement program or in local newspapers if you have a privacy/confidential hold placed on your record. However, your name will still be announced during the Commencement proceedings. If you currently do have a privacy/confidential hold on your record, but ***do want*** to be listed on the program and in newspapers, please contact the Records Office at RecordsOffice@BristolCC.edu by Friday, April 27.
